

## Cosmetic / Fungal Nail Refurbishment.



Cosmetic / Fungal nail refurbishment is a new treatment offered by the podiatrists at the WalkWell Clinic using Wilde Pedique products.

This treatment is a modern way of correcting the appearance of an unsightly nail.

The gel substance that is used to restore the nail contains anti fungal and anti bacterial agents. It is applied to the nail to provide an acceptable looking nail, which feels natural and fits perfectly to the nail plate.

Wilde Pedique is specifically used for correcting and restoring the toenails. There is no odour, discolouration and it will not damage the natural nail as it grows. The anti-fungal / bacterial properties treat the fungal nail as well as providing protection from any further infections that may occur.

The refurbishment can be to part of the nail or the full nail. A UV light is used to harden the gel material after it is appropriately applied to the nail. This treatment is suitable for people of all ages, diabetics and individuals that perform lots of activity and sports.

### Can be used to treat:

- Fungal nail infections whilst providing a cosmetically acceptable nail.
- To replace nails that have been lost through sports or trauma.
- To provide a prosthetic or false nail for patients that have had nails removed, surgically and permanently.
- To support a damaged nail that has split down the centre of the nail.

Wilde Pedique is a treatment more commonly used for fungal nail infections.

Onychomycosis is the medical term for fungal nail infections. It is caused by dermatophytes (fungal micro-organisms) that infect the nail plate. They enter the nail plate multiplying and causing the nail to change in many ways including the shape.

A fungal nail is characterised by:

- Colour changes,
- Debris underneath the nail,
- Odour,
- Thickening or sometimes thinning of the nail.



Fungal nails can cause pain due to pressure from shoes.

Fungal nails have little to do with personal cleanliness. Wearing tight fitting shoes is enough to weaken the nails and as a consequence can expose the underlying nail bed to infection.

Fungal nails can take a long time to resolve if treated with over the counter medicines.

But, thanks to the WalkWell Clinic there is another solution for treating fungal nails without having a thick, discoloured and unsightly nail.

### It only takes 4 simple steps:

- Reduce the nail thickness using a file or nail drill. Remove all of the infected nail.



- Apply a layer of the Wilde Pedique gel to the natural nail and skin. Shape the nail to produce the best cosmetic effect for the patient.



- The gel material is cured under a UV lamp to harden. The previous step is repeated and cured under the UV light once again.



- A finishing solution is applied to the nail and it is now finished and looks cosmetically different.
