

Wilde Pedique Nail Refurbishment for Fungal Nails



Onychomycosis is the medical term for fungal nail infections. It is caused by dermatophytes (fungal micro-organisms) that infect the nail plate. They enter the nail plate multiplying and causing the nail to change in many ways including the shape.

A fungal nail is characterised by:

- Colour changes
- Debris underneath the nail
- Odour
- Thickening or sometimes thinning of the nail



Fungal nails can cause pain due to pressure from shoes.

Fungal nails have little to do with personal cleanliness. Wearing tight fitting shoes is enough to weaken the nails and therefore can expose the underlying nail bed to infection.

Fungal nails can take a long time to resolve if treated with over the counter medicines.

But, by using Wilde Pedique, you can have an aesthetically pleasing nail which is not thick, discoloured or unsightly.

Wilde Pedique:

Wilde Pedique nail refurbishment is a new treatment offered by the podiatrists at the WalkWell Clinic using anti-fungal, anti-bacterial and anti-viral gel products.

This treatment is a modern way of treating a fungal nail as well as giving it an aesthetically pleasing look.

Wilde Pedique is specifically used for correcting and restoring the toenails. There is no odour or discolouration, and it will not damage the natural nail as it grows. The anti-fungal/bacterial properties treat the fungal nail as well as providing protection from any further infections that may occur.

Depending on the nail damaged by the fungus, the full nail or only part of the nail can be treated with the Wilde Pedique. This treatment is suitable for people of all ages, diabetics, and individuals that undertake a lot of activities and sports.

It only takes 4 simple steps:

- We reduce the nail thickness using a file or nail drill. This is to remove all the infected nail.



- We then apply the anti-fungal treatment, followed by a layer of the Wilde Pedique gel to the non-infected nail and skin. The nail is then shaped.



- The gel material is cured under a UV lamp to harden. We then repeat the previous step.



- A finishing solution is then applied to the nail; the application of the nail is now complete. Once applied, the nail will allow a new healthy nail to grow out without any fungal infection present. The nail applied can last anywhere between 6-12 weeks.

We recommend regular infills to make sure that a healthy nail can continue to grow.



Wilde Pedique can also be used to:

- Replace nails that have been lost through sports or trauma.
- Provide a prosthetic or false nail for patients that have had nails removed surgically and permanently.
- Support a damaged nail that has split down the centre of the nail.
